Do you need support to attend the Having a Say Conference (HaS)?

It is a good idea to talk to your service and/or family about what support you need to attend.



You may need funding in your NDIS Plan to pay staff to support you to travel and participate at HaS.



Funding for staff can come from your Core Supports budget.

However, if you want support with other costs of attending e.g. accommodation, registration, transport,) you will need to:

- ask your planner for Capacity Building Innovative Social & Community Participation funding in your plan
- Having a Say is a skill development opportunity that is funded under 'camps' [Price Guide item number 09_010_0125_6_3]
- Have this budget either Plan Managed or Self-Managed as you will need to pay organisations that are not NDIA registered agencies



Funding in your NDIS plan is possible because Having a Say supports you to:

- Build skills and self-confidence through participating, volunteering, presenting, performing and learning heaps!
- Be inspired by peers
- Learn about rights and responsibilities
- Gain information on what support is available in both the community and disability services
