## About the Having A Say Conference

Having a Say Conference has an average attendance of 1000 participants each year. Participants come from all across Victoria and every State of Australia.



Having a Say is not an ordinary conference, it is not just talk; it is people sharing their stories and discussing issues that will impact their lives, such as jobs, health, speaking up and what they've achieved. It is far more than a conference - it is an 'experience' for all involved.

Having a Say conference provides people with a disability with opportunities to experience new things, to contribute, learn, present, perform, to be inspired by their peers and celebrate achievement.

## Aims of the Having a Say Conference

The Having a Say Conference aims to empower people with disability through:

- Opportunities to celebrate ability and achievement
- Being part of the planning and running of the conference
- Participation in an annual conference in a rural location of Victoria
- The opportunity to 'have a say' about issues that affect their lives
- Opportunities to be heard by politicians, government and service providers
- The opportunity to meet people from around Victoria, Australia and overseas



## Information for Exhibitors

- ✓ Chairs are provided and tables are 1.8m long with approx. 1.2 metres behind them.
- ✓ Display boards are not included in the table hire fee
- ✓ Please bring your own tablecloth as these are not provided
- ✓ You can bring your own display board as long as it fits within your table's display area & doesn't stick out & become a trip hazard
- ✓ You receive two complementary day registrations for each day including all day tea/coffee and morning and afternoon teas (cake/fruit etc.)
- ✓ Any extra staff at your stand will be required to be registered (i.e. fill out form) and pay am/pm tea catering costs of \$15 per day
- ✓ Please note that exhibitor day registration does not include evening events
- ✓ Electricity can be provided if it is needed for your display (not just for charging)

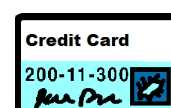
