The Team

The VALID Families Team members are all parents of people with disability who are participants of the NDIS. Our training is delivered from a 'peer' perspective using personal experience and knowledge to support families. Team members are trained in person-centred planning, working with families and facilitation.

The Course

The Families as Planning Partners Course assists family members to:

 Empower their family member with a disability

- to have a good life
- Understand the way the NDIS and the disability support system works
- Understand the range of NDIS plan management options and responsibilities
- Develop strong personcentred plans with/for their family member with a disability
- Gather important evidence to support the case for NDIS funding
- Build collaborative and positive working relationships

Course Content

The course has 4 sessions. During the course, families can choose to develop a 'whole of life' Person-Centred Plan (PCP) and/or an updated version of their NDIS Plan.

Course Duration

The course sessions are approx. 4 hours long, are usually held during the day but can be conducted in the evening.
