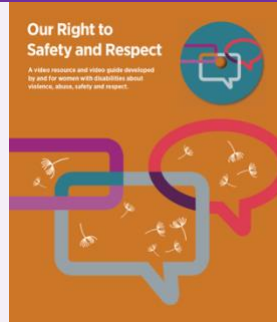
Violence Prevention & Our Community: Video & Workshop
