HaS is focused on providing opportunities for people with disabilities to present, talk about issues they care about, celebrate their achievements, perform, volunteer, discuss rights and responsibilities and gain information on their choices, including from the Expo.

In 2025 there were over 110 presenters with disability and over 650 conference attendees each day (plus members of the public visiting the Expo). In 2026, the theme for HaS will be: '25 years: Strengthening our voices for a better future!'.

To celebrate the achievements of people with disabilities we're encouraging people with disabilities who are running their own small businesses to take part in the Expo this year.
